Public Comment on Property Tax Increase

The Lumpkin County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a millage rate, which will require an increase in property taxes over the roll-back rate by 15.10 percent in unincorporated Lumpkin County, and 20.84 percent in incorporated Lumpkin County.

Steven Scoggin, 410 Lewis Brown Road, said his tax appraisal increased 80% from last year and he does not understand why. He said he turned in an appeal form to the office of the Tax Assessor on May 11, but he has not heard anything back from them. Mr. Scoggin believes his home was over-appraised.

The County Manager said he would get Mr. Scoggin's contact information and find out what is going on with his appraisal from the Chief Appraiser.
